It's Hard On The Holidays

Carrie buried her head and cried silently as the topic of our group discussion hit a broken spot in her heart. Kelley moved to sit by her and gently comfort her as we talked. Carrie is a bright, gentle and caring 14 year old who has experienced more loss and trauma in her short life than most seasoned adults. She is spending her days in a juvenile detention center awaiting a safe placement after multiple suicide attempts, school truancy, running away and theft. Her life shifted under her feet as her family dissolved after her mothers death.

Kim sits beside her sharing words of comfort. She is 16 and her ability to push forward and show such concern for others is a beautiful miracle. She writes songs to try to process her pain. She shared the one about her mother with us. It was heart wrenching. The depth of abuse and neglect of a child at the hands of a careless adult is astounding. Scars all over her arms are a witness to her pain. They are small picture of how her heart and mind must look.

Each week we spend time with these young women, one of our new outreach opportunities. We share the hope and healing that God has for them as well as tools to help them deal with "life" stuff. They love learning how God created them, how their brains and bodies work. Healthy relationship tools and how to make LIFE choices. We also have the privilege of meeting with families in a recovery home and homeless shelter. We are in awe of the doors that God has opened and how He is moving this little ministry into new territory. Keep posted in the months to come to hear more about the expansion of services and...the expansion of a new larger location. Also, please join in the New Baby Bottles & Beyond. The Bear Hugs (prayer bears) have been a much larger blessing than we anticipated. They are going with clients into places we cannot go.

Carrie is working hard on her education and getting healthy while she waits for the next step in her life. She is always looking out for others and asked us is we could bring the Bear Hugs for the other girls, She shared how much hers meant to her. She left hers with her sister

when she was on a home visit. Kim shared with us that they have found her placement in a foster home. She was very sad because it is far from her siblings and no where near her childhood home. They both have asked us to have the people who prayed over their bears, continue to pray for them.

We can hardly fathom how these precious children can even function in life. We are so thankful that God opened these doors for us to meet them, speak into their lives and pray for them. Please keep them all in your prayers. God is passionately pursuing them.

Getting Involved



Early Childhood Development

Did you know that brain development in the first year of life establishes the way we process everything for the rest of our lives? Yes, culture, family of origin and trauma impact our lives as well, but science is clear, it's how we process these influences that really matters. This way of processing was established in the first years of our lives. At LIFEBRIDGE we believe in supporting individuals in making LIFE choices. One of the ways we do this is through the discipleship and education of young parents. If you have a heart for parents, education and early childhood development, we need your help. Please contact us for details on how you can get involved.



LIFE Ministry Training is provided by LIFEBRIDGE as an ongoing training option for individuals who have a heart to help others and for personal development. LMT consists of video training sessions, group discussion and opportunities to put your training into practice. Each month, there will be a focus such as mental health, recovery services and discipleship. Some topics will include a special all day trainings such as the Mental Health First Aid, Family Recovery Training, and Bridges Out Of Poverty.

Enrolled participants can participate at three levels, finding what will fit best with their lifestyle and availability. LMT is Free and participants can enter or leave the training throughout the year. We recommend staying with it all year.

- LEVEL I Participants will receive the Video Assignments & Schedule to complete each month.
- LEVEL II Participants will receive the Video Assignments & Schedule to complete each month. They will also attend at least one Group Discussion each month at LIFEBRIDGE.
- LEVEL III Participants will receive the Video Assignments & Schedule to complete each month. They will also attend at least one Group Discussion each month at LIFEBRIDGE. LEV-EL III participants will also have the opportunity to practice hands on training and work with an Advisor for Personal Development.
